

Ski Patroller – Fulltime - Winter 2026/27

Responsibilities:

- Lots of skiing
- First aid assessment, treatment, and transportation via toboggan or snowmobile
- Daily and ongoing hazard assessment
- Daily trail crew tasks such as fencing and shovelling
- Assisting with avalanche control missions
- Patient care record keeping and incident investigation paperwork
- Dispatcher duties including: Microsoft Office; phone, radio, handwritten communications
- Emergency lift evacuation (working from heights)
- Knowledge and application of the Alpine Responsibility Code
- Includes working weekends, holidays, and nights
- Other duties as assigned
- Reports to snow safety manager and patrol supervisors

Requirements:

- Advanced skiing ability (black diamond moguls)
- Valid 80-hour wilderness first aid certification or equivalent from an approved Alberta OHS or Workplace BC training provider
- Valid CPR or BLS certificate
- High level of physical fitness and the ability to work outdoors for long hours in ski boots in all-weather conditions
- Excellent communication and customer service skills
- Driver's License
- Must be able to hear and speak clearly for communication using radios and phones
- If applicable, must have a valid Working Holiday Visa

- AST 1 or 2
- CAA Level 1
- Climbing and rope skills
- Snowmobile operation
- Previous ski patrol experience
- Access to reliable transportation is required for some positions
